Local Law Number 15 for the year 1986

**A Local Law establishing  
regulations for the licensing  
of hawking, peddling, door-to-door  
selling and for licensing  
any itinerant merchants**

BE IT ENACTED by the board of trustees of the village of Margaretville as follows:

Section 1. All persons are prohibited from hawking or peddling or selling door to door or selling from wagons, trucks, carts, trailers, motor vehicles or the like within the limits of the Village of Margaretville or selling by auction or soliciting the sale of any goods, wares, foodstuffs, contracts, services or merchandise in the streets of the Village or upon any Village property except the peddling of meats, fruits and farm produce by farmers and persons who produce such commodities as provided by the General Business Law, until such person shall have first obtained a license therefore, as provided by Section 2 hereof.

Section 2. Licenses shall be issued by the Mayor, specifying the fee to be paid therefore, and every such license shall be countersigned by the Clerk of the Village who shall keep a record thereof and of the amount of the fee to be paid therefore; and upon presentation of such license to the treasurer of the village so signed and countersigned, and the payment to the Treasurer of such fee, the Treasurer shall indorse thereon his/her receipt of the license fee, and no license shall take effect until the receipt of the treasurer has been endorsed thereon.

Section 3. The fees for each such license issued shall be set at a rate determined by the Board of Trustees, and each such rate shall be for a per diem rate, and each such license shall be issued for a fixed number of days, with said fee charged being the number of days issued multiplied by the fee.

Section 4. Ordinance number 18, concerning exhibitions of circuses and tent shows, is hereby repealed. Ordinance number 19, concerning prohibition or exercise of hawking or peddling without a license, dated November 29, 1939, is hereby repealed. This local law shall take effect immediately.
