Local Law Number 11 of the year 1986

**A Local Law establishing vehicle and
pedestrian traffic regulations**

BE IT ENACTED by the board of trustees of the Village of Margaretville as follows:

Section 1. Any person who obstructs or encumbers the streets, sidewalks, highways or public parking places or parking lots maintained by the Village of Margaretville, by placing or leaving or causing to be placed or left thereon or therein any wood, lumber, or timber of any kind, or any box, boxes, barrels, carts, wagons, hand wagons, abandoned motor vehicles as defined in the Vehicle and Traffic Law and regulations promulgated thereto or any other thing whatsoever that shall render it dangerous or inconvenient to pass or repass in the day or night, after being notified to move the same shall be fined criminally the sum of \$25 dollars for each day or part thereof that the obstruction remains.

Section 2. For purposes of this local law, notice or being notified shall mean any such giving of notice or notification by the Village through its lawful agents or officials to another by taking such steps as may be reasonably required to inform that party or person that his actions are in violation of this local law.

This local law shall take effect immediately.
