

**VILLAGE OF MARGARETVILLE
LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF THE YEAR 2022
A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING PARKING RESTRICTIONS
WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF MARGARETVILLE**

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Margaretville as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to establish parking restrictions during certain months on all Village streets and in certain of the municipal parking lots located within the boundaries of the Village of Margaretville. The Board of Trustees of the Village finds that this local law strikes a balance between keeping such parking areas available for all to use, and the need to conduct snow clearing operations in order to preserve public health and safety.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law § 1640, which provides the Village with broad authority to prohibit, restrict or limit the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles upon public streets and upon property owned or leased by the Village, and to remove and store any vehicle in violation of such restrictions.

Section 3. Seasonal Parking Restrictions on Village Streets and Notice Thereof

- A. There shall be no parking on any Village street between the hours of 11:00PM and 7:00AM from November 1 through April 1 of each year.
- B. The Streets Superintendent shall cause to be erected and maintained appropriate and clearly visible signs to provide notice of parking restrictions from November 1 through April 1 of each year. The type, number and location of such signs shall be determined by the Streets Superintendent.

Section 4. Seasonal Parking Restrictions for Certain Municipal Parking Lots

From November 1 through April 1 of each year, parking shall be restricted in certain municipal parking lots located within the Village, as follows:

- A. There shall be no parking in the municipal parking lot on Walnut Street, behind the Village offices, between the hours of 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM.
- B. There shall be no parking in the Village Park between the hours of 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM, unless otherwise expressly permitted by authorized officers, employees or agents of the Village for special events.
- C. In the Binnekill parking lot, located off of Bridge Street, parking shall be permitted as follows:

1. On odd numbered days, parking shall be permitted on the North side of the lot (closest to Binnekill Stream) from 5:00 PM daily and shall be in effect until 4:59 PM the following day. There shall be no parking on the North side of the lot on even numbered days during the aforesaid time period.
 2. On even numbered days, parking shall be permitted on the South side of the lot (closest to Delaware River) from 5:00 PM daily and shall be in effect until 4:59 PM the following day. There shall be no parking on the South side of the lot on odd numbered days during the aforesaid time period.
 3. Instructions for compliance.
 - a. After 5:00 PM on odd numbered days, park on the South side of the lot so that you “Park for Tomorrow”.
 - b. After 5:00 PM on even numbered days, park on the North side of the lot so that you “Park for Tomorrow”.
- D. The Streets Superintendent shall cause to be erected and maintained appropriate and clearly visible signs to provide notice of seasonal parking restrictions in the municipal parking lots identified in this section. The type, number and location of such signs shall be determined by the Streets Superintendent.

Section 5. Violations

- A. Any vehicle parked in violation of this local law shall be subject to removal by or under the direction of the Streets Superintendent or his/her authorized agent or designee. After the removal of any vehicle as provided in this section, the Streets Superintendent or his/her authorized agent or designee may store or cause such vehicle to be stored in a suitable place. The owner or operator of any such vehicle shall be responsible for all expenses actually and necessarily incurred in effecting such removal and storage, and may redeem such vehicle upon payment of same to the person or entity with whom the vehicle is stored. In no event shall such removal and storage charges exceed the per-day charge for same, as established by resolution of the Board of Trustees from time-to-time.
- B. It shall be the duty of the Streets Superintendent or his/her authorized agent or designee to ascertain to the extent possible the owner or operator of the vehicle and to notify him/her of the removal and disposition of such vehicle and of the dollar amount required to redeem same. The Streets Superintendent or his/her authorized agent or designee shall also, without delay, report to the Village Clerk the removal and disposition of any vehicle so removed and stored as provided in this section.

Section 6. Severability

The provisions of this Local Law are separable and if any provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such illegality, invalidity or unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, subsections, words, or parts of this local law or their application to other persons or circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this local law would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid, or

unconstitutional provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part had not been included therein, and as if such person or circumstance, to which the local law or part thereof is held inapplicable, had been specifically exempt therefrom.

Section 7. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
