Local Law No. 1 of the year 2000

A local law ESTABLISHING PARTIAL TAX EXEMPTION FOR REAL PROPERTY OF AGED PERSONS (Insert Title) PURSUANT TO REAL PROPERTY TAX LAW SECTION 467

Be it enacted by the BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the (Name of Legislative Body)

Section 1. The Board of Trustees of the Village of Margaretville hereby exempts from taxation real property owned by a person or persons qualifying for exemption under Real Property Tax Law Section 467 based on the following sliding scale:

Income of \$7,000 or below	50% exemption
Income more than \$7,000 but less than \$8,000	45% exemption
Income of \$8,000 or more but less than \$9,000	40% exemption
Income of \$9,000 or more but less than \$10,000	35% exemption
Income of \$10,000 or more but less than \$10,900	30% exemption
Income of \$10,900 or more but less than \$11,800	25% exemption
Income of \$11,800 or more but less than \$12,700	20% exemption
Income of \$12,700 or more	No exemption

Section 2. The provisions of Real Property Tax Law Section 467 shall govern the administration and interpretation of this Local Law, and no exemption shall be granted unless the applicant is entitled to an exemption under the provisions of said law.

Section 3. The Board of Trustees of the Village of Margaretville may amend the income levels and sliding scale set forth above at any time by adopting a resolution following a public hearing.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
