ORDINANCE NO. 35

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING PARKING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF MAIN STREET BETWEEN THE BULL RUN BRIDGE ON THE EAST AND FAIR STREET BRIDGE ON THE WEST.

BE IT ORDAINED

SECTION 1. No omnibus, taxi cab, motor vehicle, automobile, truck or other vehicle of any kind shall be parked or be left standing, attended or unattended, on the south side of Main Street in the Village of Margaretville, New York, between the Bull kun Bridge on the east and Fair Street bridge on the west, at any Time FRITTLUMBER YARD.

SECTION 2. There shall be forthwith erected by said village signs at each end of said area so restricted indicating the area in which omnibuses, taxi cabs, motor vehicles, automobiles, trucks or other vehicles, shall not stand or park.

SECTION 3. The violation of any of the provisions hereof by any person shall constitute disorderly conduct and a person violating any provisions thereof shall be a disorderly person and shall be subject to arrest, prosecution and punishment as provided in Section 338 of the Village Law.

SECTION 4. The penalty for each and every violation of any of the provisions hereof shall be and hereby is fixed at the sum of not more than TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00).

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
