Local Law Number 9 of the year 1986.

A Local Law providing for a village attorney

BE IT ENACTED by the board of trustees of the Incorporated Village of Margaretville as follows:
That the Village may employ an attorney and pay him a reasonable compensation. This compensation shall require said attorney to be available for consultation by members of the village board and to attend village board meetings when necessary. This compensation is to be paid on an annual basis. Such annual compensation shall not include extraordinary services, including litigation and matters that do not arise in the ordinary course of village business. The Board also may, from time to time, employ such village attorney to attend to attend to such other legal matters such as litigation and matters that do not arise in the ordinary course of village business not included in the original compensation and pay him for such services. Such compensation shall be in addition to the village attorney's annual compensation and shall be a legal charge against the village.

This local law shall take effect immediately.
