Village of Maryaretville

Local Law Number 5 of the year 1986

A local law regulating projecting and overhead signs and provision for fines and injunctions

BE IT ENACTED by the board of trustees of the incorporated village of Margaretville as follows:

That Ordinance Number Twenty-One providing for the regulation of overhead signs within the incorporation's territory is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. No sign of any nature shall be allowed to project in, over or upon any of the streets or sidewalks within the Incorporated Village of Margaretville.

Section 2. No advertising signs shall be placed upon, on, or over any roof of any building, commercial or otherwise, lying within the V.O.M.

Section 3. Any person, partnership, firm, entity or corporation violating this ordinance shall be deemed a disorderly person and shall be liable to and pay fines and penalties to said Village for each and every violation hereof occurring within a twenty-four hour period as follows:

Sub. (a) For the first violation, not more than twenty five dollars:

Sub. (b) For the second violation, not less than twenty five dollars and not more than fifty dollars:

Sub. (c) For each subsequent violation, not less than fifty dollars and not more than one hundred dollars.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect immediately.
