Local Law Number 19 of the year 1986

**A Local Law to establish regulations
for the removal of refuse lying upon
or near Village sidewalks**

BE IT ENACTED by the board of trustees of the village of Margaretville as follows:

Section 1. All filth, refuse or garbage of any description lying upon or near any sidewalk within the Village of Margaretville or other real property owned by the Village of Margaretville shall be removed once a week by the owner or lessor of the real property upon which said filth, refuse or garbage is found; except, however, any establishment serving food for consumption as a restaurant shall be required to remove such filth, refuse or garbage twice weekly.

Section 2. All filth, refuse or garbage which contains foodstuffs is to be kept in vermin proof containers which are covered and shall remain covered until removed.

Section 3. Any such person, corporation, partnership, association or entity who shall not remove such filth, refuse or garbage lying upon or near Village sidewalks or other real property owned by the Village in violation of this local law shall be deemed to forfeit a civil penalty of twenty five (\$25) for each offense and said civil penalty shall be a lien upon said premises.

This local law shall take effect immediately.
